- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum (English) content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust process of planning and moderation
- Provide focused and intensive teaching targeted at 'C' students in order to improve the quality of their demonstrations of learning against the relevant year-level achievement standard
- Develop partnerships and a strategic plan for transition to secondary. Introduction of the AVID program in year 5&6 to enable a smoother transition to secondary through program familiarisation.
